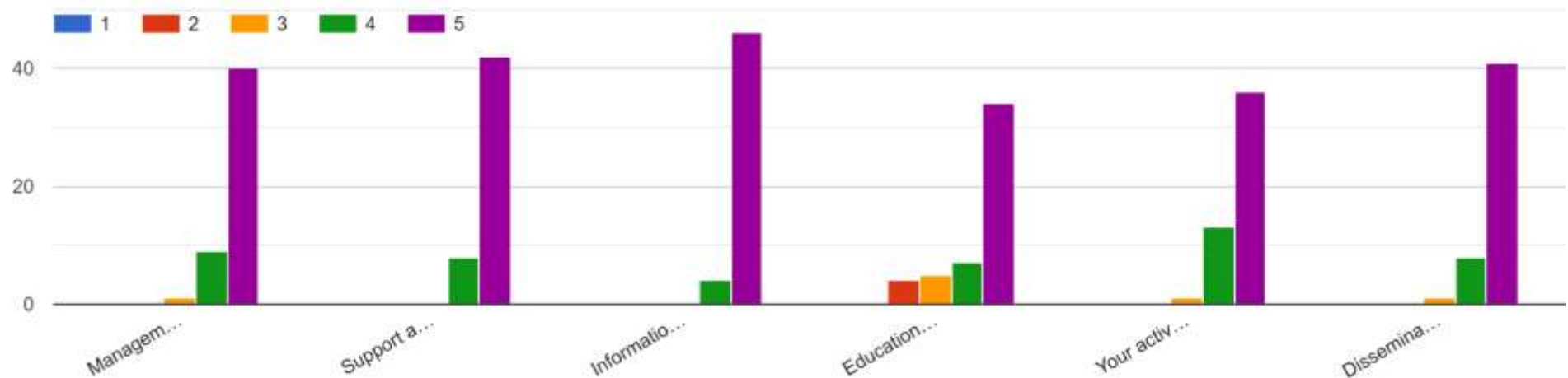

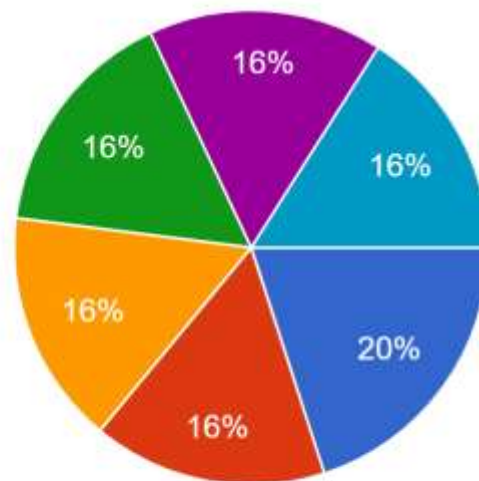

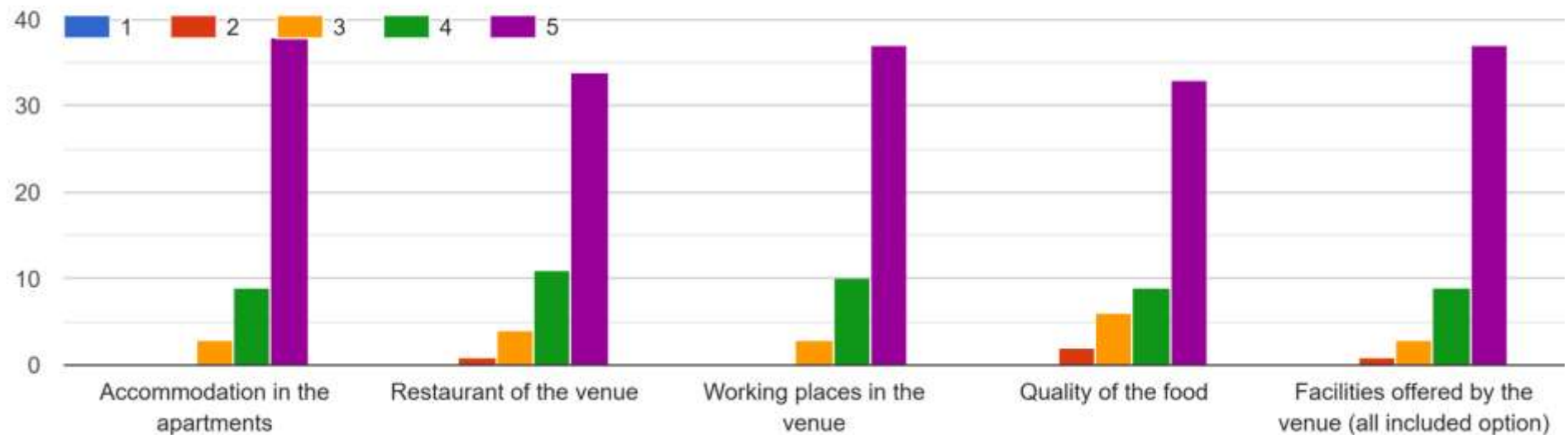

food was very good i liked the fact that almost every day there was different food for the place it is very good place with very friendly people and entertainments almost every evening

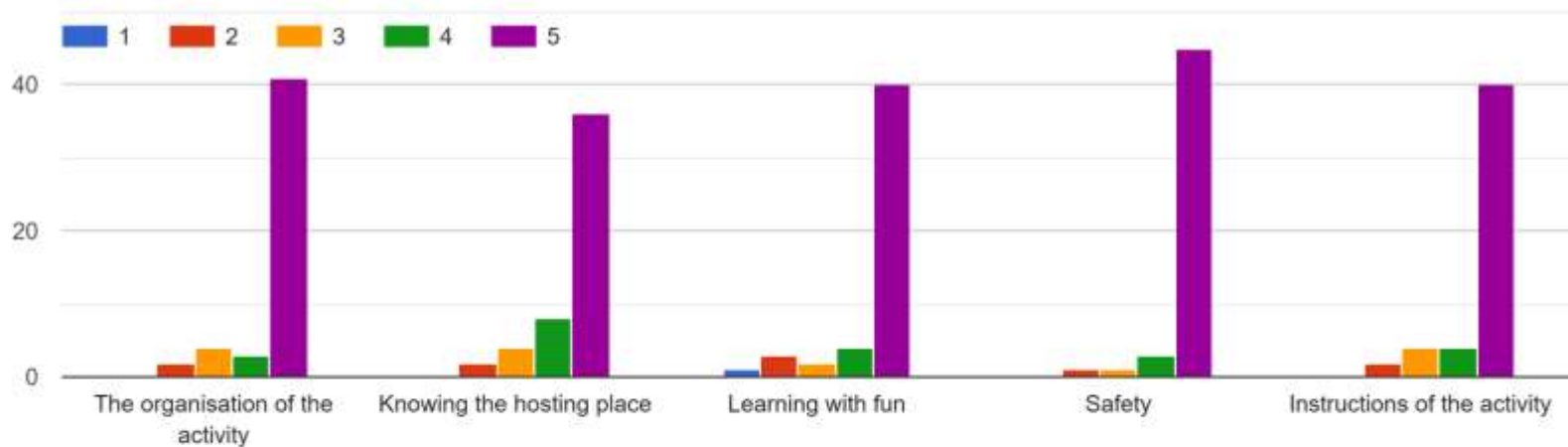
